

Australasian Skin Cancer Congress 2026 Delegate Registration Terms & Conditions

Definitions

- Australasian Skin Cancer Congress 22 – 24 May 2026 (**the Event**)
- The Star Brisbane (**the Venue**)
- Skin Cancer College Australasia (**the Organiser**)
- The person named on the Event registration (**Delegate**)

In-person registration

- 1) In-person registration for the Event includes access by the Delegate at the Venue to all Event sessions; food and beverages at welcome drinks on 22 May 2026; daily catering for lunch and breaks; unlimited access to recorded Event sessions and additional recorded content up to 24 November 2026.
- 2) In-person Event registration does not include accommodation at the Venue.
- 3) In-person Event registrations are capped in accordance with safe occupancy limits at the Venue. Availability is on a first-come basis.
- 4) In-person Delegates agree to comply with all applicable Venue rules and directions to ensure the safety of all those in attendance.
- 5) In-person Delegates may choose to book accommodation at the Venue under the discounted rates negotiated by the Organiser. Availability of accommodation is subject to demand and is determined by the Venue.
- 6) Payment for accommodation, non-included food and beverage or other goods and services consumed by the Delegate at the Venue is the sole responsibility of the Delegate.
- 7) Free on-site parking for In-person Delegates is no longer provided by the Venue. Terms and conditions, access methods and amounts applicable to on-site parking discounts are set by the Venue and not guaranteed to Delegates.
- 8) It is the Delegate's responsibility to access discounted on-site parking rates using the method provided by the Venue. No refunds are available from the Organiser or Venue if the Delegate fails to follow the method provided to access the on-site parking discount.

Virtual registration

- 9) Virtual registration for the Event includes live online access by the Delegate to all Congress sessions; unlimited use of all functions on the online Event platform; unlimited access to recorded Event sessions and additional recorded content up to 24 November 2026.
- 10) The Organiser is not responsible for the stability or quality of Delegates' internet connection or providing devices to allow the Delegate to connect to the Event.

Registration changes

- 11) Event registration may be changed, at the discretion of the Delegate, from in-person to virtual attendance or vice versa up to **5.00pm (AEST) 3 April 2026**. The difference in registration fee will be charged / refunded to process the change.
- 12) After this date, the mode of Event attendance cannot be changed, except at the discretion of the Organiser.

Discretionary cancellation

- 13) Event registration may be cancelled by submitting a request to the Organiser via email info@skincancercollege.org no later than **5.00pm (AEST) 3 April 2026**. An administration fee of \$250 will apply.
- 14) Cancellations after this date will not be refunded.
- 15) An Event registration may be transferred to another person at no extra charge.

Event interruption or cancellation

- 16) If circumstances beyond the control of the Organiser, including but not limited to national or state government pandemic restrictions, venue disruption, or natural disaster, prevent the Event from being held at the Venue, the Event will proceed in a fully virtual format.
- 17) If circumstances beyond the control of the Organiser prevent the Event from being held at the Venue, and/or prevent the Delegate from attending in-person at the Venue:
 - a) in-person Event registration will be converted to virtual Event registration. No charge will apply for this change and the difference in registration fee will be refunded.
 - b) in-person Event registrations will not be refunded.
 - c) virtual Event registrations will not be refunded.
 - d) where applicable, additional tickets purchased for the welcome drinks to be held at the Venue on 22 May 2026 will be refunded in full.
 - e) where applicable, additional event tickets purchased for on-site events will be refunded in full.
 - f) the Organiser will not be liable for any travel or accommodation cancellation costs incurred by the delegate.

Notice of photography, video and audio recording

- 18) By attending and participating in the Event, the Delegate acknowledges that photography, video and audio recording may occur. By completing this registration and attending the Event either in-person or virtually, the Delegate consents to such recording media and its release, publication, exhibition or reproduction by the Organiser in future education or promotional material.
- 19) No recording, broadcast, or republication of the program content is permitted by Delegates without the written approval of the Organiser.
